Report of the Meeting

Thursday 27 April 2023

Pre-Council Executive Board Meeting

Pre-Council Journal Club

Facilitated by Natalia Zarbailov

The Topic for discussion was dedicated to Primary Care effectiveness evaluation via postdoctoral research study.

Summary of the thesis of habilitated doctor in medical sciences with title "Development of primary care based on family medicine in the Republic of Moldova and determinants of effectiveness" was presented by Natalia Zarbailov. The results were divided in three chapters: first, dedicated to the political willingness for the PHC development in Moldova; second, professional satisfaction and motivation of family doctors; and third, opinion of the beneficiaries of primary care services. Methodology and research tools selection was explained before the results. Questions lead to the discussions. Key messages: The research is an opportunity to highlight the situation in PHC at the country level that offers evidence, which stakeholders and decision makers have to consider.







Session 1: Warm-up session, Welcome, presentations, approval of meeting agenda; business meeting part 1; updates on committees' and task groups' work.

Warm-up Session 1

We introduced a novelty in EURACT Council meetings: 15-minute warm-up sessions before the beginning of each day's work. These sessions were coordinated by Arabelle.

Warm-up 1: «Roundtable to get familiar with participants' names»

Goals:

- Integrate new members of the Council.
- Provide a structured informal beginning to a business meeting.
- Contribute to a positive working environment.
- Make a link with "knowledge" part of the triad of teaching.

In turn each participant says his or her Christian name with a positive adjective about themselves that starts with the same letter. "Pavlo" can say "Passionate Pavlo" for example.

The members are asked to mention the other names + attributes before their own. Thus, providing a great number of repetitions of each person's name and attribute.

Appendix 2 – Report from EURACT's representative in WONCA EUROPE EB

Since the last report, the WONCA Europe Executive Board has held two face-to-face meetings (Brussels and Naples) and monthly video conferences. The following issues on the agenda of WONCA Europe may be of interest to members of the EURACT Council:

Core activities

- WONCA Europe has organized a series of webinars titled Controversies in Cancer Screening, devoted to lung, prostate and gastric cancer. These webinars with participation of featured experts provided valuable insights into the current controversies and debates surrounding these screening practices. Recordings from the webinars are available to watch online in English, French, German and Spanish at the following address:. https://www.woncaeurope.org/page/past-webinar-recordings
- WONCA Europe of the European Federation of Periodontology held in July 2022 in Madrid, Spain the joint workshop to review the latest evidence for associations between periodontal diseases and systemic diseases, such as diabetes, and respiratory and cardiovascular diseases. As a result the paper: "Association between periodontal diseases and cardiovascular diseases, diabetes and respiratory diseases: Consensus report of the Joint Workshop by the European Federation of Periodontology (EFP) and the European arm of the World Organization of Family Doctors (WONCA Europe)" has been recently published in the Journal of Clinical Periodontology.
- All members of the colleges and associations belonging to WONCA Europe will be entitled to get 20% discount for the Author Processing Charge for papers published by the European Journal of General Practice.
 The discount code is available through all WONCA Europe Member Organizations and should be input on all submissions to the journal through the journal's current online submission system.
- WONCA Europe has recently approved Lifestyle Medicine special interest group (SIG). The new SIG will focus on chronic diseases that can be prevented or managed through adopting healthy lifestyle practices.
- WONCA Europe has announced a call for the WONCA Europe projects. Two projects will be financed, each by
 a sum of 5,000 EUR. Fourteen applications have been received and are under revision. The results will be
 announced shortly.
- On request of the Rural Family Doctors' Association of Latvia WONCA Europe has sent a letter of support to Latvian and European politicians and decision makers declaring willingness to cooperate and provide expertise and experience to seek constructive solutions for current problems envisaged by PHC in Latvia.

WONCA Europe Conferences

- 28th WONCA Europe Conference "Making choices in Primary Care" will be held on 7-10 June 2023, in Brussels, Belgium at SQUARE Convention Centre.
- During WONCA Europe Conference in Brussels 2023 there will be WONCA Europe Open Meeting organized under the title: "Balance between traditional face-to-face visits and new telemedicine options"

- WONCA World Conference 2023 will be hosted by the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) and will take place on 26-29 October 2023, International Convention Centre (ICC) Sydney, Australia
- 29th WONCA Europe conference will be held in Dublin, Ireland on 25 28 Sep 2024.
- In 2025 WONCA Europe will host WONCA World conference in Lisbon, Portugal. So, in this year there will be no separate scientific meeting organized on European level.
- WONCA Europe EB evaluated 4 bids for the 2026 WONCA Europe Conference Call: Turkey (Antalya), Greece (Athens), Germany (Munich) and France (Paris). The host of the 2026 Conference will be awarded by voting during the Council Meeting in Brussels.

Internal affairs

- Dr Aaron Poppleton UK, representing European Young Family Doctors Movement in WONCA Europe Executive Board has been elected the Chair of the WONCA Europe Bylaws Committee.
- During the Council Meeting in Brussels there will be voting on the proposal, to include the European Network
 for Prevention and Health promotion in Family Medicine and General Practice (Acronym: EUROPREV) as a
 Member at Large of the WONCA Europe Executive Board.
- The call for the Anthem of WONCA Europe under the title "From GPs to GPs" has been announced. Both music and lyrics in English are requested and to be sent to WONCA Europe secretariat. The final decision will be taken during the Council meeting in Dublin 2024. The winner will be announced after an anonymous vote.



• This report was prepared at the request of the EURACT Executive Board, provided by Barbara Toplek on January 27, 2023. The opinion was developed on the basis of the provided summaries of actual revenues and costs incurred in connection with the functioning of the organization in 2022. Additionally, overview of income and expenditures from 2021 was reviewed as a reference point for financial management of the organization in 2022. These summaries include incomes and expenses grouped by category, as well as a detailed register of individual transactions for 2022. At the request of the second auditor, data on the planned budget for 2022 was also provided.

- The budget revenue and cost statements are consistent with the day-to-day transactions register. The statements are transparent and seem to reflect the financial aspect of the organisation's functioning in 2022.
- Compared to the planned budget, the actual income was slightly lower (49 578 instead of 50 600 €). The expenses were higher than planned (51 450 instead of 41 600 €), mainly due to the extra costs related to the celebration of 30th anniversary of the organization in Copenhagen and Krakow.



- Increased expenses in 2022 compared to previous years are related to the return to normal activity, including the organization of stationary meetings of the EURACT Council, after the period of pandemic restrictions.
- It is noteworthy that the inflow of funds from membership fees is still lower than planned (25,948 instead of 30,000 €), which is most likely caused by difficulties in returning to normal activity in the period after the COVID-19 pandemic and instability caused by the war in Ukraine.



- The overall financial situation should be described as stable and safe, which is reflected by the current balance for the end of 2022 at the level very close to the previous year. I am convinced that we can owe it to the solid, reliable and systematic work of colleagues managing the organization's finances, including, above all, the Honorary Treasurer, the President and the Administrative Secretary.

Conclusion of my audit

• I can approve the financial report for 2022. The financial data are all recorded chronologically in a straightforward way, distributed into logically formed columns. The calculated sums of each column are placed in the top line, these are checked to be correct. All data are easily explainable – knowing the tasks of EURACT and the special circumstances that were the case in 2022 – the first post-COVID year.



Supplementary remarks to the audit: Re. Income:

- Membership fees were predicted to 30.000 € and the actual collected fees were around 26.000 €. But it is very problematic, that nearly half of this amount (around 12.000 €) are fees from 2021 and even earlier, and only the rest is from 2022. It also raises the question: how much is still lacking from 2022?
- This situation makes it very difficult for the treasurer and for the Council to have an overview of the actual financial situation.
- I will encourage Council to make a payment system, so the fees from year XXXX are collected and transferred in year XXXX.



Re. Expenditures:

- In the predicted budget the ISSECAM project was only budgeted as an income – in 2022 there were also expenditures of 11.700 € in this project – this must have been after an EB decision.
- There were anniversary activities in Spring and Autumn budgeted at 2.500
 €. The actual expenditures can be found as expenditures during Council meetings in Copenhagen and Krakow and the total is close to 14.000 € this raised expenditure was also after an EB decision.
- A new website allocation of 4.000 € was not used in 2022.



Re. Balance:

- Compared to 2021 the balance is stable around 100.000 € and that means that EURACT has a healthy economy, as this balance would allow normal activities in more than one year if all income fell away.
